



Our Infant Program...

At County North, there is always interaction between adults and infants in all care giving routines such as feeding, diapering, and playing. We provide nurturing care to develop trust and security with a predictable environment and consistent care giving. Your child's day is based on his/her own schedule: they eat when they are hungry, sleep when they are tired and play while they are awake. Developmental records are documented on a continual basis.

There is ongoing communication with parents. A daily note about your child's day is provided: what and when he/she ate, took naps, diaper changes, whether it was wet or a bowel movement, a notice of what you'll need for the next day, diapers, wipes, etc. and overall how the day was.

Parents will provide...

- Open communication with our staff concerning your child.
- Bedding, sent home every Friday for parents to wash.
- Pre-made formula, bottles and caps, baby food, diapers, wipes – items necessary for your baby's day. No glass is allowed in the Center.
- Extra clothes in case of spills, spit up, or leaks.
- Please mark all items with child's first and last name.
- Appropriate outerwear for outside walks and play, please include a hat.
